EXECUTIVE ORDER No. 23-2018

EXECUTIVE ORDER FORMALLY TRANSFERRING ADMINISTRATIVE AND  
MANAGEMENT RESPONSIBILITY FOR SPECIFIED NON-TRUST LAND FROM THE  
MONTANA DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION TO THE MONTANA  
DEPARTMENT OF JUSTICE

WHEREAS, this Administration is committed to utilizing the assets of the State of Montana to promote the highest efficiency of government operations;

WHEREAS, in furtherance of that commitment, Executive Order No. 02-2015 approved the transfer of administrative and management responsibility for certain real property in Butte, Montana from the Department of Transportation (MDT) to the Department of Justice (DOJ) for purposes of facilitating the construction and operation of a new DOJ facility on that property;

WHEREAS, MDT and DOJ now wish to transfer administrative and management responsibility for an additional portion of that real property to facilitate the construction and operation of an additional DOJ structure on the property;

WHEREAS, MDT and DOJ also wish to correct a portion of the description of the real property that was subject to the transfer originally approved by Executive Order No. 02-2015; and

WHEREAS, it will be in the best interest of the State to accomplish this additional transfer given that DOJ will be constructing and operating a new structure on the additional property.

NOW, THEREFORE, I, STEVE BULLOCK, Governor of the State of Montana, by virtue of the authority vested in me under the Constitution and the laws of the State of Montana, do hereby approve the transfer of administrative and management responsibility for the additional property and the terms of the Amendment No. 1 to the 2014 Agreement between MDT and DOJ.

This Order is effective immediately and will remain in effect until it is rescinded or superseded by subsequent Executive Order.
