Policy Recommendations

- 5. Merging District Funds Transportation fund be separated out and weighted GTB be used in the transportation fund
- 6. Fund balance reappropriated remains with the district and an incentive mechanism is developed to allow the funds to be reserved for "appropriate" future use
- 7. Natural resources for sustainable and predictable revenue

Guidance Concepts

- 1. Proposals must consider the definition of a basic quality system of elementary and secondary schools in Montana.
- Universal mill per dollar.

- 3. Proposals must retain the equity components and should simplify understanding for the public.
- 4. Clear recognition and discussion of possible benefits and burdens by using maps.
- 5. Proposals must take into consideration tax burden to avoid extreme tax increases on a particular subgroup.
- 6. Revenue recommendations must be sustainable and reliable and have a mechanism for adjusting the budget to inflationary increases.
