



Post-secondary education matters, especially 2-year colleges <sub>7/3/2008</sub>




# Montana's Changing Demographics 2007-2017

#### Today

- One in two MT HS students go on to a college after graduation.
- Less than one in five students get a 4 year degree from MUS in 4 years.

#### Future Challenge:

- MT's population will grow by 6.6 %
- Less babies and more elders.
- High school graduates expected to decline by nearly 20 %
- Traditional college students --18 to 24 -projected to decline 19 %

#### Kindergarten to College Workgroup Commonly known as P-16, K-16, P-20, K-20 Councils

- Adopted Bd of Ed Meeting, July 13, 2006
- Purpose and Duties -- Assist the Bd of Ed with:
- planning and coordination to build a strong education system in Montana
- meeting deliverables (completing their homework assignments),

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- coordinating strategic plans of the Board of Public Education and the Board of Regents,
- gathering information, and
- providing advice.
- Meets 4 times a year

# Kindergarten to College Workgroup Members

#### 9 voting members:

- A representative of the Board of Regents
- A representative of the Board of Public Education
- The State Superintendent of Public Instruction or designee
- The Commissioner of Higher Education or designee
- A Student Assistance Foundation representative
- A Montana School for the Deaf and Blind representative
- The Governor or designee
- A public at-large member (student)
- A public at-large member (parent).

#### Ex-officio non-voting members:

- The Director of the Department of Public Health and Human Services or designee
- The Commissioner of Labor and Industry or designee
- The Director of the Department of Commerce or designee
- The Governor's Chief Business Development Officer or designee
- The Governor's Budget Director or designee
- The Chief Information Officer or designee.


