Executive Order No. 12 - 2005

EXECUTIVE ORDER DESIGNATING THE CHILD SUPPORT ENFORCEMENT
DIVISION OF THE DEPARTMENT OF PUBLIC HEALTH AND HUMAN SERVICES AS
A CRIMINAL JUSTICE AGENCY UNDER THE MONTANA CRIMINAL JUSTICE
INFORMATION ACT OF 1979

WHEREAS the Child Support Enforcement Division ("CSED") must provide location services as part of its State Plan for child support enforcement services, in accordance with 42 USC 654 and 42 USC 666;

WHEREAS, as part of those location services, the CSED must use appropriate location sources, including those used by the State of Montana for purposes relating to motor vehicles (such as driver's license and vehicle registration information) and relating to law enforcement (such as criminal justice information), in accordance with 45 CFR 303.3; and

WHEREAS to access some of this location information the CSED must be designated a "criminal justice agency" as defined by Mont. Code Ann. § 44-5-103.

THEREFORE, I, Brian Schweitzer, Governor of the State of Montana, in accordance with the authority vested in me by the laws and Constitution of the State of Montana, and pursuant to the Montana Criminal Justice Information Act of 1979 [Mont.

Code Ann. Title 44, Chapter 5, and Mont. Code Ann. § 44-5-103(7)], do hereby designate the Child Support Enforcement Division of the Department of Public Health and Human Services as a Criminal Justice Agency.
